

WRITINGTASK 1

The two given maps show road access to a city hospital in 2007 and in 2010.

It is evident that steps have been taken in mere three years to manage traffic around the city hospital and to enable better accessibility.

The city hospital was encircled by the Ring road which was connected to the city road by the hospital road. On either side of the hospital road lay bus stops with staff and public car park east of it. This arrangement was improved by building two roundabouts at both the junctions of hospital road with ring road and city road. A bus stop was made west of the hospital road with a link to both roundabouts instead of the six bus stops that lined the road earlier. Another improvement was the separation of staff and public car parkings. The staff car parks remained

at its original location but the public car park was made along the Eastern boundary of the ring road.

In summarise, a shift in location of bus stops, expansion and separation of parkings and building of two new roundabouts took place in the three years in order to improve road access <sup>to</sup> the city hospital.

## TASK 2
